Email received January 2017 – Powys War Memorial Project
 - Any World War 1 memorial in Powys is eligible to apply for / benefit from funding.
 - Up to £2700 per memorial can be awarded to repair, restore or maintain war memorials. This represents a maximum of 90% of the total cost of the works. The remaining 10% will need to come from match-funding, e.g. Town and Community Councils or local heritage societies.
 - Up to £200 per memorial can be awarded to maintain, improve or enhance war memorial settings or surroundings, e.g. repairs to fences or gates. This represents a maximum of 70% of the total cost of the work. The remaining 30% will need to come from match-funding.
