290302. Declarations of Interest by Councillors on any items on the Agenda. None

290303. Approval and signing of Minutes from the previous meeting on 22nd February 2017. The minutes were approved as an accurate record. All agreed.

Mrs J Carter addressed the Council inviting the Members to an event at St Llonio's Church on 11th June 2017. The aim is to celebrate the strength of the community and to raise funds for the installation of toilet facilities and ease of access to the Church.

It was agreed to include this as an agenda item for the next meeting.

290304. Continuing Business:

Cllr M Jones informed the Council that the Post Office is in discussions with the Village Hall with a view to offer an outreach service in the village.
- c) Agenda content review.

290305. Community Council Car Park

No fly-tipping problems have been reported.

It was brought to the attention of the Council that the pump in the car park toilet is broken. K & S Toilets submitted a quote of £187.59 + VAT for a replacement pump. The Council agreed to go ahead with the repairs. Proposed by Cllr A Owen and seconded by Cllr J Deakins. All agreed.

290306. Play Area – Annual Inspection

It was agreed to accept the quote from Powys County Council of £60+VAT and to delay the inspection till later in the year.

290307. Highways:

- a) Llandinam Zebra Crossing & Bus Stop

Mr Andrew Jones of NMWTRA advised that works to combine the belisha beacon and streetlight on one pole on the Lion side of the road will be taking place shortly. At the same time the bus stop location will be moved further from the crossing.

- b) Caravan at Middle Esgair – this has now gone. PCC will arrange for the fly-tip left behind to be cleared and for the road and the layby to be swept.
- c) Speeding through the village and the installation of a speed indicating device were discussed. Clerk to chase this again.
- d) Drainage problems in Barn Lane
This has not been done – clerk to follow up.
- e) It has been brought to the attention of the Council that a private drain has been dug up alongside the road from the Triangle by Penrhiw to the junction with the road to Little London causing the road to break up and likely to collapse. Clerk to contact Highways.
